

Travel from John F. Kennedy Airport (JFK) to American Airman by Railroad

TAKE [AIRTRAIN](#) TO THE LONG ISLAND RAILROAD (LIRR) **JAMAICA TRAIN STATION.**

After arriving at [JFK International Airport](#) look for terminal signs leading to the [AirTrain](#). The AirTrain is the most economical, convenient and fastest way to travel from JFK Airport to American Airman. Travel to and from JFK via [AirTrain](#) is **\$5.00 USD** as you enter or exit the system. There will be automated kiosks and AirTrain personal available to assist you in purchasing the fare. [AirTrain](#) travels to the [Jamaica LIRR Station](#) from JFK every 5 to 10 minutes. The AirTrain ride to the Jamaica Station takes about 10 minutes. Print the full [AirTrain Brochure](#) and take it with you.



TAKE THE LONG ISLAND RAILROAD FROM THE JAMAICA STATION TO THE [RONKONKOMA TRAIN STATION.](#)

After arriving at the Jamaica LIRR Train Station follow the illuminated signs to the correct platform. Be sure your get on the train that takes you to the [Ronkonkoma Train Station](#). Be sure to review the [train schedule](#). You can purchase your ticket aboard the train from the conductor as he passes through or from a kiosk. Be sure to have U.S. legal tender in cash for the conductor. The ride from Jamaica to Ronkonkoma is about 50 minutes. The fare from the Jamaica Station to Ronkonkoma is less than **\$15.00**.

SHUTTLE BUS TO CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL

After arriving at the Ronkonkoma LIRR Train Station call the [Crowne Plaza Hotel](#) and they will send a free shuttle bus to collect you at the station and transport you to the hotel. The local number is 631-758-2900. Be sure to tell the hotel that you are a client of American Airman Ground School or Heritage Flight Academy.
